## | Background

Along with the enlargement of the REMIS Health Center in Darsilami Gambia a SuMeWa|SYSTEM substitutes the inadequately secured water supply facilities. This became necessary due to the high water quality requirements in the health sector. Next to the infirmary itself, the system also supplies training facilities and staff accommodations. Employees of the Fraunhofer IWES integrated the water purification uprepared for future extensionsnit into the off grid system. Today the system can supply up to 9,000 liter of safe water to the complex and is. The symbiosis of both, solar energy supply and decentralized water treatment increases the efficiency of both and reduced costs at the same time.
